WHERE ARE YOU VOTING?

DECIDE WHERE TO VOTE

College students can vote at their college or home address, but remember where you register is where you vote

To register election day bring an ID and proof of residence

DEADLINES TO KNOW

- USPS recommends allowing 14 days for mail-in (absentee) ballots (Oct 20th)
- MN Registration due Oct 13th (or register in-person on the day of): Mail-in ballots postmarked Nov 3rd (ballots will be accepted through Nov 10th)
- ND Mail-in ballots postmarked by Nov 2nd
- SD registration must be received via mail by Oct 19th : Ballot received via mail by Nov 2nd
- WI registration due Oct 14th : Ballot received via mail by Nov 3rd
